learned counsel for the State via video conferencing.

By way of the present application, the petitioners have sought for pre-arrest bail in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No.169 of 2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366A read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as reproduced in para 123 of the case diary wherein the alleged



victim has categorically stated that she went together with one Alok Kumar out of her own sweet will and married on 25.07.2019 in a temple at Delhi, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Rosera at Samastipur in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No.169 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
