ORAL ORDER

3 03-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for bail vide order dated 23.09.2019 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge I-cum-Special Judge (S.C./S.T. Act), Hajipur at Vaishali, in connection with Jandaha Police Station Case No.204 of 2019 registered under Sections 341/323/ 324 /504 /506 /354 / 479/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3(i)(r)(s)/3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Most of the offences of the Indian Penal Code alleged are bailable. The allegation against the appellant is general and omnibus.



Considering the aforesaid facts and completion of investigation of the case, let the appellant, above named, who has got no criminal antecedent, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The appellant shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

(c) The appellant shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and appeal is allowed.
