This application is for restoration of Cr. Rev. No. 734 of 2018 which stood dismissed on 25.06.2019 for non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 14.05.2019.

The reason for non-compliance of the peremptory order is explained in the petition. Hence, for substantial justice, dismissal of Cr. Rev. No. 734 of 2018 is hereby set aside and Cr. Rev.
