3 11-12-2020 Heard Mr. Bhola Prasad, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ram Anurag Singh, learned counsel for the Union of India through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner in this writ petition seeks quashing for cancelling the application of the petitioner for upkeeping of Archaeological Gardens in the State of Bihar for the financial year 2019-2020 and the same was allotted to respondent no.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the petitioner has already filed representation before the Director General of Archaeological Survey of India and the writ petition
