3 05-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 406, 420, 379, 467 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused person fraudulently withdrawn a sum of Rs. 1,81,000/- from the account of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 9.9.2019. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted in the present case. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is no substantive evidence to suggest his implication in the present



case. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to deposit a sum of Rs. 75,000/- in the court below which shall be subject to the final disposal of the case.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R..

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **on deposit of a sum of Rs. 75,000/-in the Court below which shall be subject to final disposal of the case,** it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. IV, Saran, Chapra in connection with Dariyapur P.S. Case No. 34 of 2019.
