Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Panapur P.S. Case No. 157/2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 30/30(a)/38/41 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
recovery has been made from the Scorpio vehicle and not from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted
that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In view of the aforementioned facts and
circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on
bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court
below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing



bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Excise, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Panapur P.S. Case No. 157/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
