APP for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Mahila P.S. Case No.87 of 2017 for the for the offence
punishable under Sections 498A,341,323,406/34 of the IPC and
Section ³/₄ Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits
that petitioners are falsely been implicated in this case. Further
submits that petitioner nos.1 & 2 are father-in-law of the
informant and petitioner no.3 is mother-in-law of the informant
and they are no concern with the said occurrence.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



petitioners, above named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks in connection with Mahila P.S.
