Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with  
Nawada P.S. Case No.57 of 2019 for the offence punishable  
under Section 302/34 of IPC and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner, who is Mama of the bride, has been falsely  
implicated in this case. From perusal of the allegations levelled  
in the first information report, it appears that there is nothing  
specific is alleged against this petitioner. The allegations  
levelled are general and omnibus in nature. Moreover, on  
realizing the real truth, the parties have compromised the matter  
vide Annexure-2. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case  
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No.57 of 2019 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara, subject to the conditions as laid down in section 438(2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
