2 22-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner being the husband is apprehending his
arrest in connection with Banka (Barahat) P.S.Case No.662 of
2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341,
323, 379, 498(A), 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is
willing and ready to keep his wife with full dignity and honour.
It is further submitted that there will be no recurrence of any
mental torture and harassment to the Opposite Party No.2 by the
petitioner in future.



Considering the aforesaid fact, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka/successor Court in connection with Banka (Barahat) P.S.Case No.662 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
