3 16-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Yogapatti (Nawalpur) P.S. Case No. 175 of 2019 registered under Sections 304B and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the allegation that the victim was done to death for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry within three years of her marriage with Mohan Mukhiya, I am not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to petitioner nos. 1 to 3, namely, Kariman



Mukhiya, Nagina Mukhiya and Ramesh @ Akhilesh Mukhiya.

Their prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail is rejected.

So far as the petitioner no. 4 Tetari Devi is concerned, she is directed to be released on bail, the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Yogapatti (Nawalpur) P.S. Case No. 175 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
