2 06-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehends their arrest in connection with Sandesh P.S. Case No. 171 of 2018 registered under Sections 328, 304B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submit that petitioners who are daughter-in-law and brother-in-law are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case with false and concocted story. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation for demand of dowry and torturing against the petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IX, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Sandesh P.S. Case No. 171 of 2018 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
