the State.

The petitioner is aggrieved by the selection of

one Basudeo Ram for being granted license even though

he is a resident of a different place and his wife is a

member of the Panchayat Samiti.

From the averments made in the writ petition, it

appears that the petitioner has already objected to the

selection of aforesaid Basudeo Ram *vide* an objection

petition which has been brought on record as Annexure-

3 to the writ petition.



Under the aforesaid circumstances, the Sub-Divisional Officer, Bikramganj, Rohtas (Respondent No. 3) is directed to dispose off the objection petition of the petitioner, within a period of four weeks, to be counted from a reminder letter by the petitioner within a period of one week.

The objection petition shall be disposed off by a reasoned order which shall be communicated to the petitioner.

The writ petition stands disposed off accordingly.
