2. Heard Mr. Tribhuwan Narayan, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Parmeshwar Mehta, learned Additional Public Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as the ‘APP’) for the State.

3. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Deo PS Case No.73 of 2019 dated 06.06.2019, instituted under Sections 406, 409, 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
