2 16-09-2020 Heard Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Alok Ranjan, learned A.C. to A.A.G.5 through video conferencing.

The petitioner in this writ petition seeks direction for disposal of appeal preferred by the petitioner against the order dated 10.06.2006 as contained in Memo No.570, issued under the signature of respondent no.3, the Sub-divisional Officer, Bettiah Sadar, West Champaran by which the licence of the petitioner has been cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this writ petition as the appeal filed by the petitioner has already been disposed of. It is further submitted that the



petitioner may be permitted to file revision petition against the appellate order.
