3 09-06-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned APP through video conferencing.

During course of conduction of raid followed with search at the cow-shed belonging to the petitioners, altogether 10.260 litres of country made wine has been recovered. Furthermore, it has been alleged that both the petitioners succeeded in their escape.

Considering the nature of the allegation in consonance with the principle decided by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav v. State of Bihar* as reported in *2019(2) PLJR 1089*, let petitioners, namely, **1. BAIJU RAI @ BAIJU KUMAR and 2. ARJUN RAI @ ARJUN KUMAR**



be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise at Patna in connection with Khajekalan P.S. Case No.390 of 2019 corresponding to Special Case No. 8333/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
