Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner
rather 15 litres of country made liquor has been recovered from
the house of the petitioner which is joint family property. He
further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as
stated in para-3 of the bail petition.

However, petitioner is agreed to deposit Rs. 10,000/-
in the Juvenile Justice Fund of the State Social Welfare



Department.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, on deposit of the aforesaid amount, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned IIIrd District and Sessions Judge, Nalanda (Biharsharif) in connection with Sare Police Station Case No. 97 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
