3 27-05-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned APP through video conferencing.

On getting confidential information with regard to assemblage of anti-social elements, a raid was conducted at the house of Shiv Ratan Das and during course thereof, as is evident, all of them managed to escape while the fire arms in terms of seizure list were recovered from a maize field belonging to Shiv Ratan Das while other items were recovered from the house of Shiv Ratan Das. Later on, Shiv Ratan Das was apprehended who made inculpatory extra-judicial confessional statement and also shown, Mukesh Pandey, Md. Rayees and Md. Firoz and other to be involved therewith.

Although petitioner has got chequered history but in the facts and circumstances of the case, more particularly, not



being named in the FIR, petitioner, Sawan Choudhary is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Forbesganj PS Case No. 424/2019.
