Heard both sides.

The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

This is the 5th attempt of the petitioner for grant of bail. A report was called for from the Additional Sessions Judge in seisin of the case. The learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-Patna reported vide letter No. 20 dated 26.02.2020 that the case has already been fixed for judgement on 05.03.2020.
