APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323,
325, 307, 504, 302, 120(B) of the I.P.C.

There is general and omnibus allegation against 10
FIR named accused and 09 unknown to have assaulted with
different weapons to the brother of the informant, as a result
whereof, he died.

Submission is that the Doctor has found only two
injuries at the head which was cause of death and considering
the general and omnibus attribution against several person,
some other co-accused have been allowed bail by a Coordinate
Bench of this Court in Cr.Misc. No.72560 of 2019 alongwith



Cr.Misc.No.62258 of 2019. Petitioner is in custody since 17.07.2019. Investigation of the case is already complete. There is no material to substantiate that petitioner is going to tamper with the evidence or hamper the trial.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Khiri More P.S. Case No.31 of 2019, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case as well as the petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the learned Trial Court, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
