In course of argument learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to demonstrate that before moving this Court, the petitioner has complied with the requirements as



explained in the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Mrs. Priyanka Srivastava & Anr. Vs. The State of U. P. & Ors.** reported in **AIR 2015 SC 1758**.
