counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents.

From Annexures-P/7 and P/8, it appears that the petitioner has represented before the Vice-Chancellor, L.N.M. University for payment of U.G.C. scale of pay of the period May,1998 to December, 2005 at the old rate and for the period January, 2006 till date at the new rate. The pay verification cell of the Government of Bihar in the Education Department has verified the entitlement of the petitioner yet the petitioner has not been paid the benefit as fixed by the pay verification cell.



The representation of the petitioner in this regard contained in Annexures-P/7 and P/8 are pending since 17.02.2018 and 12.04.2018 respectively.

Under the aforesaid circumstances, the Vice-Chancellor is directed to take final decision on the representation contained in Annexures-P/7 and P/8 within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The Vice-Chancellor is also required to fix accountability on the erring officers for delay in payment of monetary benefit arising out of the pay fixation by verification cell of the State Government. The monetary benefit admissible to the petitioner must be paid within a maximum period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

In the event of delay in making the payment, the University shall fix accountability on the erring officers and pay interest @ 9 per cent per annum from the date of accrual to the date of actual payment and realize the interest payable to the petitioner from the erring officers responsible for delay.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
