ORAL ORDER

2 04-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Begusarai Muffasil P.S. Case No. 349 of 2019 registered
under Sections 414, 468, 471, 477, 120(b) of the Indian Penal
Code and 30(a) and 41 of the Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that on
perusal of F.I.R. itself, it appears that petitioner was not present
at the time of occurrence. There is no specific allegation against
him. It is also submitted that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 349 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
