The petitioner is in custody in connection with Belhar
P.S. Case No. 231 of 2019 for the offenses under Section 30(a)
(g) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016 and Section 3 of
the Bihar Mahua Flower Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he was
involved in manufacturing country made mahua liquor and from
his possession 40 Kg of mahua was recovered on search.
