A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Durgawati P.S. Case No. 267 of 2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

As alleged in the F.I.R., the case of the prosecution is that on refusal by the informant to let his cattle for grazing the petitioners along with co-accused persons having armed with Lathi-Danta and Guns encircled the informant party and firings made by



co-accused Nasim Khan and Imran Khan hit the father of the informant and the informant respectively, while the petitioners and other co-accused persons assaulted the family members of the informant by Lathi-Danta.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is case and counter case between the parties. He further submits that there is specific allegation against Nasim Khan, who fired upon the father of the informant, who has been granted anticipatory bail by order dated 17.12.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No.83488 of 2019. The injury found simple in nature.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Durgawati P.S. Case No. 267 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
