Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the Respondent-State.

It is submitted by petitioner's counsel that under the Right to Public Services Act, 2011 (*for brevity 'the Act'*), the order dated 02.07.2019 passed by the Deputy Collector Land Reforms (*for brevity 'D.L.C.R.'*) in Appeal case no. 11 of 2019, in purported exercise of jurisdiction, under Section 7 of the Act is subject to review by the Additional Collector, East Champaran at Motihari (Respondent No.3).

In view of such submissions, the petitioner may approach the Respondent No.3 within a period of four (04) weeks. It is



directed that the Respondent No.3 shall consider the petitioner’s application and pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon without raising the issue of same being availed of by any delay and on its merit expeditiously, without undue delay, preferably within a period of four (04) weeks thereafter.

The writ petition is disposed off.
