2 24-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kaluahi P.S. Case No.38 of 2019 corresponding to G.R. No.439/19 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 272, 273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from the roadside. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of



four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani, in connection with Kaluahi P.S. Case No.38 of 2019 corresponding to G.R. No.439/19, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
