Following relief has been sought for in paragraph 1 of
the present application on behalf of the petitioner:

“1. That the present writ petition is being filed
for issuance of writ of MANDAMUS for commanding
and directing the authorities for payment of pension,
gratuity, leave encashment and other emolument with



statutory interest at market rate and additionally in interest on delayed payment from date of entitlement to date of actual payment with litigating cost for unnecessary harassment and for other necessary relief/reliefs on the basis of the facts and circumstances of the case.”

On behalf of the petitioner, it is submitted that the relief sought for in the present writ application has been redressed by the respondents.

Considering the same, the present writ application stands disposed of.

In case, if any further relief still remains to be redressed by the respondents, the petitioner shall be at liberty to make a representation before the competent authority who shall consider and dispose of the same in accordance with law.
