ORAL ORDER

2 05-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent-State.

The petitioner is an Accounts Clerk in the Central Building Division, Patna. He submits that his claim for the benefits under the Assured Career Progression (*for short 'A.C.P.'*) is pending consideration before the Superintending Engineer, South Bihar Circle, Building Construction Department, Patna (Respondent No.3).

In view of the limited grievance and since no adjudication is required, the pendency of the writ petition would be futile.



The writ petition is disposed off with direction to the Respondent No.3 to take a final decision on the petitioner's claim by a reasoned and speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of three (03) months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The dues and admissible amount, based on such decision, should also be paid to the petitioner within a period of eight (08) weeks thereafter.
