4 04-09-2020 The matter has been heard *via* video conferencing due to circumstances prevailing on account of the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. Heard Mr. Bhola Prasad, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Bal Mukund Prasad Sinha, learned Additional Public Prosecutor (APP) for the State.

3. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with K Hat (Maranga) PS Case No. 312 of 2019 dated 06.05.2019, instituted under Sections 363 and 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the
