2 24-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
341,323,307,379,504,34 of the Indian Penal Code.

No allegation is there against the petitioner of
commission of any injury at the vital part of the body of the
informant or of commission of theft of cash from the pocket of
the informant. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact there is no direct material
against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the
event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a
period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Palasi P.S.Case No.284 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
