3 18-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Hilsa P.S. Case No. 679 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 420, 406 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that they are involved in snatching the truck. He further submits that the petitioners were not named in the FIR and their names surfaced on the confessional statement, yet they have not been put on test identification parade. The petitioners are in custody since 19.07.2019.



Considering the fact that the petitioners are not named in the first information report and put on test identification parade, the Court is inclined to grant bail to them. The petitioners, named above, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate 1st, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Hilsa P.S. Case No. 679 of 2018.
