5 27-05-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Dhoraiya P.S. Case No. 258 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 147, 341, 323, 325, 307, 504, 379 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code. Later on Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code has been added.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 06.08.2019. He submits that there is delay of four days in lodging the F.I.R., as the incident took place on 01.11.2018 and the F.I.R. was lodged on 05.11.2018. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that he inflicted blow on the leg and not on the vital part of the body.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he has remained in custody for more



than ten months, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on his personal bond, due to the circumstance of total lock down on account of pandemic Covid-19, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Dhoraiya P.S. Case No. 258 of 2018.
