3 19-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Section
392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the informant was snatched away Rs three lakhs
and twenty eight thousand by the unknown persons.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 30-08-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner is not named in the FIR.
His name transpired in this case on the basis of his self-



confessional statement made before the police. There is no recovery of any incriminating article from possession of the petitioner. The petitioner was not put on test identification parade.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Vth, Rosera, Samastipur in connection with Singhia P.S. Case No. 122 of 2019.
