2 21-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Mahindwara P.S. Case No. 113/2019 registered for the offense punishable under Sections 30(a)(b)(c)(f), 41 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were made from the Litchi orchard and not from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on



bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Mahindwara P.S. Case No. 113/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
