2 20-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Bhangaha P.S. Case No. 49 of 2019 registered under Sections 20, 22, 23, 27 of N.D.P.S. Act pending in the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, Bettiah, West Champaran.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case for ulterior motive and nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The seizure list does not contain the signature of the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 01.10.2019.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State opposed the prayer of the petitioner with submission that the



seized 14 Kg 800gm Ganja which is tied in plastic bag was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, I am not inclined to allow the prayer of the petitioner for bail. Accordingly, this application is rejected.
