2 17-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody seeks bail in a case
registered under Sections 30(a) and 37(b) of Bihar Prohibition
and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Allegation is recovery of 300 litres country made
liquor and 9 litres of foreign liquor from the vehicle where the
petitioner was found standing.

It has been submitted on behalf of petitioner that he is
innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case only on
basis of suspicion. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is
in custody since 09.11.2019.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below, in connection with Excise Case No. P.S. Case No. 1324 of 2019 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bond.
