3 18-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offence under Sections 341, 307 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. In fact, the co-accused having more or less similar allegation has already been granted regular bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 80239 of 2019 and the case of these petitioners stands of similar footing. The petitioners are rotting in judicial custody



since 14.10.2019. Hence, the petitioners may be enlarged on regular bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-1st, Araria in connection with Bounsi P.S. Case No.104 of 2019.
