6 24-08-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being
taken up by way of virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading 'For
Orders' under the orders of Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 302, 498A, 120B/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the
petitioner committed murder of the daughter of the informant
due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against



the petitioner. The petitioner is in para military force. The alleged occurrence is said to have taken place in his absence. The trial in respect of other co-accused has already proceeded. The informant has been examined in the said case as P.W.8, where he has denied the allegations made in the F.I.R. As per the postmortem report, the deceased is said to have died due to water drowning.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also the lockdown, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on his personal bond to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M. 6th, Nalanda, Bihar Sharif in connection with Asthawan P.S. case No.15 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Once the normalcy is restored, the petitioner shall furnish bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within a period of seven weeks to the satisfaction of the court concerned in connection



with the aforesaid case.
