ORAL ORDER

2 06-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner who is in custody seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Excise Act.

Allegation is recovery of 46.875 litres of illicit country made liquor from the vehicle from which petitioner was apprehended while he was fleeing away.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on basis of suspicion and nothing was recovered from his conscious possession. He has got no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 23.09.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/-(Twenty Thousand) with



two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending, in connection with Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case no.207/2019, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offence, after his release on bail, the trial court shall take steps to cancel their bail bonds.
