2 07-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420 and
120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Excise & Prohibition Act, 2016.

Submission is that recovery of liquor is alleged from a
hedge. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent nor the
petitioner has any concern with the said liquor.

Considering the fact that there is no sufficient material
against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be
released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or
surrender in the court below within a period of thirty days from



the date of receipt of the order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Naokothi P.S.Case No.116 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
