2 16-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are accused in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No.369 of 2019, registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The accusation is that recovery of 96 bottles each containing 180 ml Indian made foreign liquor from the Baithaka of the house of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 22.10.2019.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the, the petitioners above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, IInd cum Special Judge Excise Act, Begusarai, in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No.369 of 2019.
