learned counsel for the respondents.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
since the election has already taken place, the writ petition has



become infructuous, hence, he be granted liberty to raise an election dispute.

The learned senior counsel, for the intervenor i.e. Shri Satendra Singh, submits that it is true that the present writ petition has become infructuous.
