3. 03-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Naugachiya P.S. Case No. 345 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case is that the petitioner alongwith two other co-accused, armed with pistol, made firing on the son of the informant, but it did not hit anybody.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics. It is further submitted that as per F.I.R. itself, 15-20 rounds firing were made, but nobody got any injury, though it was a crowded place. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as nature of accusation, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. Ist, Naugachiya in connection with Naugachiya P.S. Case No. 345 of 2019, subject to condition, as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
