Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. By filing the present application, the petitioner has invoked extraordinary jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure against the order dated 27.03.2019 (G.R. Case No. 08 of 2018), whereunder, Sri Vikash Jha, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Madhubani on perusal of the materials available in the case diary summoned the accused-petitioners finding prima facie case under Sections 341, 323,



325, 354(A), 448 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code
