2 20-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 15.10.2019 in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No.80 of 2019 registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a), 41(1) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from a truck covered with canopy and a blue Jito Van near Aughar Math. The petitioner is accused in two other cases in which he has already been granted bail.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the alleged recoveries were not from the



conscious possession of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 9th Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran at Motihari, in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No.80 of 2019.
