The Certificate Officer in the present case, namely,

Before finally deciding the objection petition by the
petitioner, the distress warrant shall not be executed.

The decision on the objection petition under
Section 9 shall be disposed of within a period of six weeks
from the date of production/receipt of a copy of this order.
