Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners, who are of clean antecedent, are innocent and have not committed any offence. In fact, there



is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and no specific overt act is attributed to them. These petitioners are rotting in judicial custody since 05.10.2019..
