State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Gopalpur
P.S. Case No. 122 of 2019 registered under sections 341, 323,
498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this
case. The allegations levelled are general and omnibus
against all the accused persons. As a matter of fact, it is the
opposite party no.2 who is not desirous of living with this
petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Petitioner
is in custody since 25.09.2019.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 122 of 2019..
