3 15-06-2020 The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 47 of 2019, dated 09.07.2019, instituted for the offences under Sections 420, 409, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

The substratum of the allegation against the petitioner is that he obtained appointment on the post of Assistant Teacher by submitting forged certificates.

It appears from the records that there was some suspicion regarding the certificates furnished by the petitioner, but there is no conclusive proof of the same that it was forged. Apart from this, many other persons are



being prosecuted in the instant case and some of them have been granted bail by different Benches of this Court.

Considering the facts aforesaid and taking into account the fact that the petitioner has now been dismissed from service, he, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Barh in connection with Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 47 of 2019, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
