counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

a) For directing the respondents to provide the details of work allotment and also details of expenses in completion of work under MANREGA for construction and development of Kabristan/Graveyard and for construction of boundary wall situated in Ward No.11 of Singhia Panchayat.



b) For directing the respondents to provide the details that by whose order/permission the amount was withdrawn from the Government account in the name of development of Graveyard but the development of the same has never been done but the amount has been withdrawn.

c) For directing the respondents to hold an enquiry and subsequently punish the responsible personal who all were involved in defalcation of money without doing any work.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to approach the authorities concerned afresh for redressal of his grievances.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
